INTRODUCTION:

DIRECTIONS:

Google Docs: Your paper must be completed in Google Docs and shared with me before the due date. Please select "Share" and add the tleighma@eischools.org as the email address.

Cover Page: The front page of your paper should be the cover page. On the cover page you should include the title of your paper, your name, the class, and the date.

Format: Your paper must have one inch margins, use size 11 point Arial font and be 1.5 space. The length of your paper can not be less then two full pages and not more then four full pages. Please use correct grammar and spelling throughout your paper.

Content: Your paper must coincide with your marine bird or reptile Google Slide Presentation. IT should include all the relevant information outlined on the slides.

Works Cited: At the end of your paper you must include a works cited page. It must have at least three sources and use the correct form. If you have trouble with the correct form of certain sources feel free to use www.easybib.com or a works cited App from the Google App store.
